Now in its sixteenth year of operation, the Foundation's purposes include the advancement of water conservation, water safety, wetlands preservation, development of athletic programs including sailing school and tennis clinics, sponsoring related education activities for the underprivileged, and other related activities for the preservation of natural resources.

Thank you to all the members who have donated to the Rehoboth Bay Foundation in the past. In 2007, the Foundation identified and contributed financially to projects that reflect positively on RBSA and furthered the Foundation's mission. A sampling of these contributions includes education programs at the Center for the Inland Bays (James Farm); the boating education of the Sea Scouts of Sussex County; and swimming instruction for financially disadvantaged children at the Sussex YMCA. This year also, the RBF made a donation to the U.S. Coast Guard, Indian River Station. Also, the Foundation was the first to grant monies to assist in the restoration of the World II tower (oceanside) opposite the RBSA clubhouse. And finally Delaware River & Bay Lighthouse Foundation and Delmarva Low Impact Tourism Experiences received money.
